Thursday, April 18 DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Friday, April 19 DUBLIN ARRIVAL & GALWAY

Land at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities before meeting your CIE Tours driver/guide, who will welcome you to Ireland. Have breakfast at a local venue before journeying to the bustling city of Galway. After checking into your hotel, you will have some time on your own. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome drink followed by dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Dinner & Overnight: Hotel Meyrick, Galway

Saturday, April 20 ARAN ISLANDS & DUN AENGUS

Take a short ferry ride from Rossaveal to Inis Mor, the largest of the three Aran Islands. These rocky islands are renowned for the hardy islanders who maintained traditional fishing and farming. The Irish language is still spoken widely. Next, take a minibus ride to Dun Aengus, a huge pre-historic fortress perched on sheer cliffs, which fall away to the Atlantic Ocean below. Have a look around Kilronan before returning to Galway in time for dinner.

Dinner & Overnight: Hotel Meyrick, Galway

Sunday, April 21 ATLANTIC SHEEPDOG

Leaving Galway, drive to into County to visit Atlantic Sheepdogs, where you will get the opportunity to experience farm life and see some of the world's smartest sheepdogs, working in their natural environment. The travel to Donegal, where you will check in for dinner and your overnight stay.

Monday, April 22 SLIEVE LEAGUE

This morning, visit Slieve League Sea Cliffs, where the highest point reaches 1,972 feet making them the highest in Europe. The cliffs drop straight down to the wild Atlantic waves below and you will see marvelous vistas. Return to Donegal, where you will have some time to relax before dinner with your group.

Tuesday, April 23 DERRY WALK & BELFAST

Upon arrival to Derry this morning, join a local guide for a walking tour around the ancient city. View the Guildhall, St. Columb's Cathedral, the Diamond and the 16th century walls. Continue on to visit the Giant's Causeway, an impressive area of hexagonal columns formed over 60 million years ago by cooling lava which has given rise to many legends. Then transfer to your hotel in Belfast, check in and settle into your room. The remainder of the day is free for individual pursuits and dining.

Overnight: Grand Central Hotel, Belfast

Wednesday, April 24 BELFAST TO DUBLIN

Today, set off on a guided tour of Belfast. See the Albert Memorial, the Opera House and Crown Liquor Saloon. In Donegal Square view the imposing City Hall, completed in 1906. The richly decorated interior contains stained glass portraying Belfast's principal industries. In the Titanic Quarter, visit Titanic Belfast to embark on a journey through the life of the Titanic, from her conception in Belfast to her tragic end. Then travel via Drogheda to Dublin and check into your hotel. You will have some time to explore Dublin on your own. This evening, take a drive to the town of Glencullen. Discover the old-world atmosphere of Johnnie Fox's Pub as you enjoy dinner and some traditional entertainment.

Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin

Thursday, April 25 DUBLIN HIGHLIGHTS

Set off with a local guide who will show you around Dublin. The city has been molded through the centuries with many architectural styles, reflecting the economic, political and artistic influences. Stop to visit Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today. Finish your visit in the roof-top bar, where you can sample a draft of Guinness. Next, visit Kilmainham Jail (subject to availability) to see what punishment was like during its years of operation from 1796 to 1924. Learn about political prisoners, especially from the 1916 Rising, detained here because of their efforts to shape Ireland's history. The remainder of the afternoon is free to sightsee and shop. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Friday, April 26 RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

Transfer to Dublin Airport in good time to check in for your flight. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your aircraft and flying across the Atlantic Ocean back to the United States.
